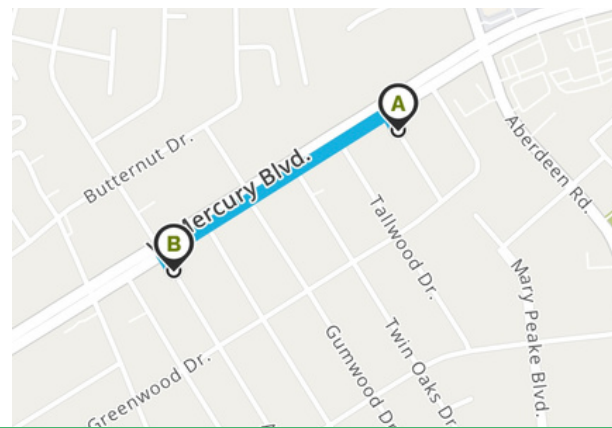


➤➤➤ GROWING BIGGER IN 2024: WE'RE MOVING!

FLOWERING PHASE (PHOTOPERIOD)

MARY, MARY, QUITE CONTRARY; HOW DOES YOUR GARDEN GROW?

➤➤➤ SHE'S A LITTLE HIGH MAINTENANCE

- To determine when to flip your plants to the flowering phase, consider your plant size. Plants will double in size in the first two weeks of flowering and, then, they will start to stack.
- To initiate flowering, lights must be turned on and off in a consistent manner, allowing for an uninterrupted period of darkness. Reduce your light cycle from 18 hours on to 12 hours of light and 12 hours of darkness,
- Feed your plants a bloom fertilizer according to the instructions/feeding cycle of the nutrient line you are using. You will do this for the first 4-5 weeks of flower.

MIKE'S PRO-TIP

In Day 10 of Flower (or your light change), hit your plants hard with a "PK Boost" -- a high phosphorous and potassium fertilizer. This encourages more bud sites to form on your plant. *Flower Finisher* by GreenGro is a wonderful example.

➤➤➤ I LIKE BIG BUDS AND I CANNOT LIE!

- Once a week, feed microbes OR compost tea for enhanced soil and plant growth. You can also feed your microbes and soil with a sweetener (e.g. GreenGro Nature's Brix), once a week.
- Once you get to Week 5 of flower, your plants will need a lot more phosphorous and potassium. To achieve density and flavor, boost according to your feeding regimen for weeks 5-8, maybe even 9-10, depending on the strain.
- In order to optimize flavors, stop feeding 2 weeks prior to harvest in soil (1 week in hydro).

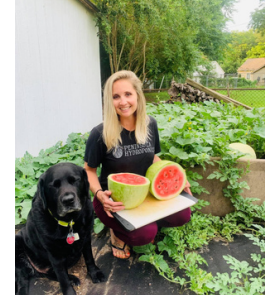

CANDIED JALAPENO CORNBREAD

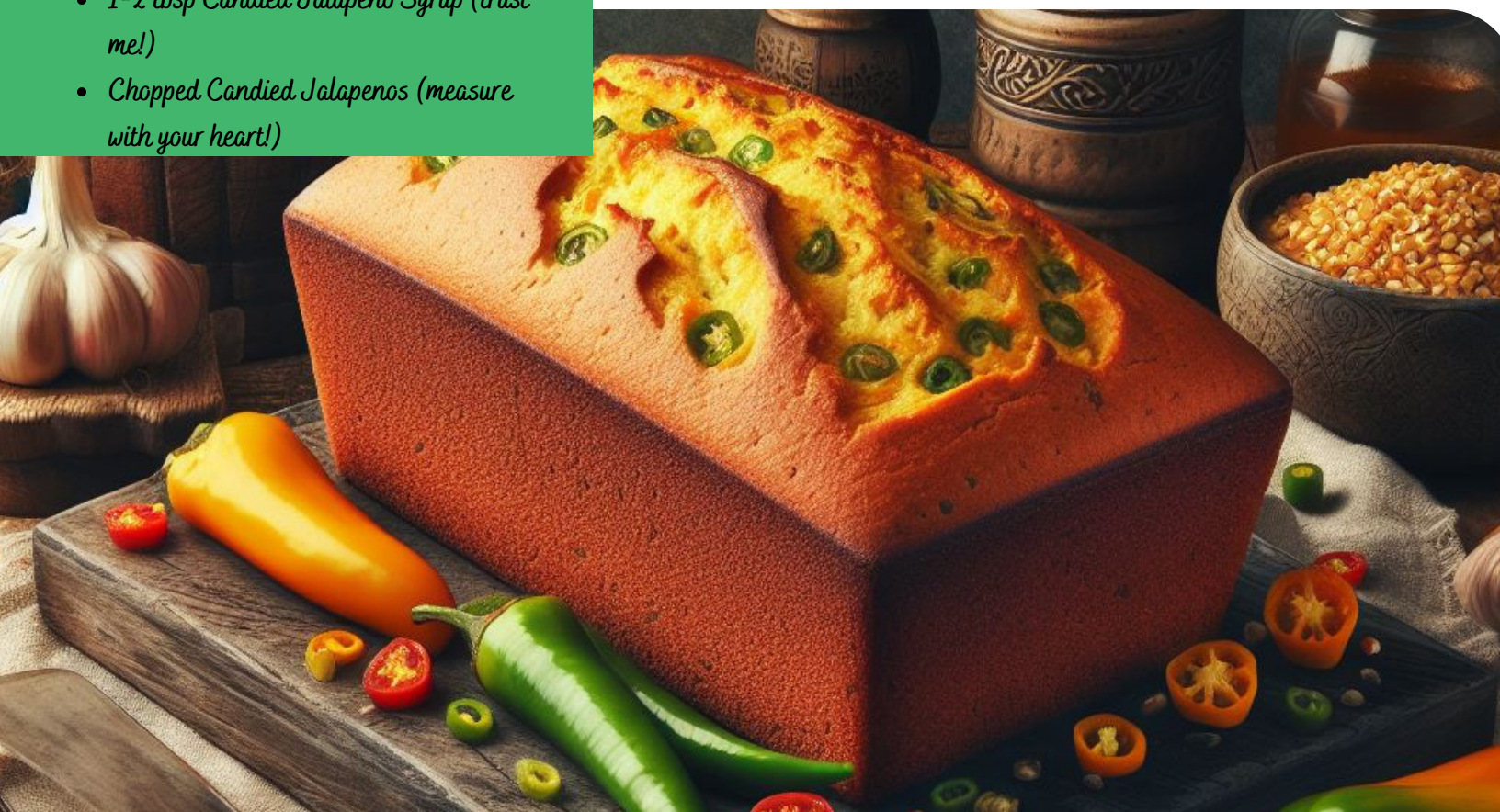
➤➤➤ THIS RECIPE GETS JALAPENO TASTE-BUDS!

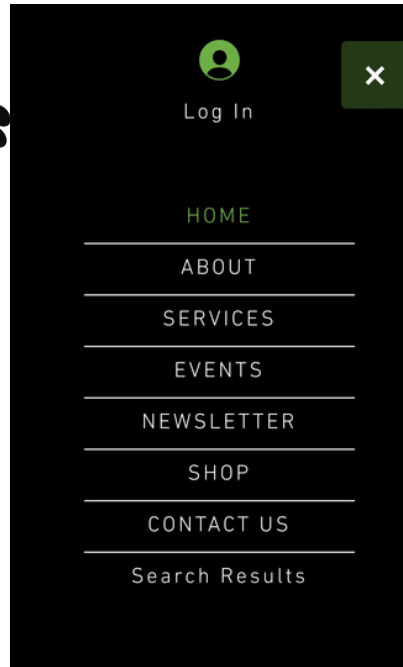
